### THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PUEBLO COUNTY, COLORADO

## APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN VIRTUAL IMAGING, INC., AND PUEBLO COUNTY, ON BEHALF OF THE PUEBLO COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the County has a need for a Full Body Security Screening System - RadPRO SecurPASS, due to the rising number of drugs being found in the Pueblo County Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, there are two known providers for this type of body scanner and the Sheriff's Office did research both scanners and obtained quotes from both known providers. The providers are Virtual Imaging, Inc. and Adani; and

WHEREAS, the quote received from Adani is \$350.00 less than the quote received from Virtual Imaging, Inc.; however Virtual Imaging, Inc. is providing a 5-year warranty whereas Adani would have only provided a 12-month warranty; and

WHEREAS, Virtual Imaging, Inc. is also proving better training. They are offering two days training with two days of operator's refresher training every year, whereas the other provider only offered 4-6 hours of training after installation with a maximum of 10 employees who could be trained; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the System is \$189,000.00 and includes the equipment, installation, calibration, three (3) days of operator training and a five (5) year warranty on parts and labor on the entire System from the time of the delivery; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office proposes to pay for the equipment by dividing the cost as follows:

- 1/3 of the cost \$63,000.00 from their Federal Forfeiture Account
- 1/3/ of the cost \$63,000.00 from the Inmate Profit Fund
- 1/3 of the cost \$63,000.00 to be provided by Pueblo County

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Pueblo County Sheriff's Office that Pueblo County enter into an Agreement with Virtual Imaging, Inc. to provide the Full Body Security Screening System for the Pueblo County Detention Center; and

WHEREAS, the Board concurs with the aforementioned recommendation and desires to enter into an Agreement with Virtual Imaging, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Pueblo County, Colorado, that:

- 1. The Agreement between Virtual Imaging, Inc. and Pueblo County, the terms and conditions of which are incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved and the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners of Pueblo County, Colorado and the Pueblo County Sheriff are authorized to execute said Agreement on behalf of Pueblo County.
- 2. The officers, employees and agents of the County are hereby authorized to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this Resolution in accordance with Colorado law.
