Dear Steve,

Thank you for the recent opportunities to review the SDS Juniper Pump Station plans and to meet and discuss those plans on September 20 and November 1, 2012. As you know, I, on behalf of Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW), have been engaged in the design review for Juniper Pump Station since 2010. The final architectural and landscaping designs for that facility are consistent with the previously approved 30% design and comply with the aesthetic character of Lake Pueblo State Park.

The three exterior brick colors selected are consistent with the initial facility design and will complement other facilities within the Park. Representative brick samples were compared to other Park buildings, including the Visitor Center, and match well. The perimeter fencing and lighting designs will help to ensure the safety of Park visitors while also providing security for the facility. Additionally, the landscaping is appropriate for the local surroundings and climate.

Please consider this letter as State Parks' concurrence with the final architectural and landscape design for the facility. Thank you for the information provided to date and we look forward to the successful completion of the SDS Project.
